### Jack Olson, Jack's Tackle Finding Walleyes in a River in Winter



Jack Olson, a 12-year-old, living in North Dakota, started Jack's Tackle in March of 2022 by making walleye spinners for family and friends, and then asked Home of Economy if they wanted to sell his spinners. They ordered some for two of their stores. From there, he approached Scheels in Grand Forks, which purchased his product, and expanded to other markets such as bait shops, resorts and more retail stores in stores and cities throughout northern North Dakota and Minnesota. His products are currently in 21 stores. He's expanded his product line to include walleye jigs, ice fishing jigs and apparel. New this year, Jack came out with an Ice Rod line of a walleye rod and a panfish rod.

Jack is proud of many things about his young company, but one thing that makes him particularly proud and happy is partnering with Carson Wentz's AO1 Foundation. This past summer, he worked with campers from Camp Conquers to color a shallow diving crankbait. Two winners from the camps are selected for Jack to custom-paint the crankbait to match the design of the two campers. For every crankbait Jack sells, he donates \$1 back to the AO1 Foundation.

When Jack isn't making tackle or coming up with new ideas for his business, he enjoys golfing, fishing and hunting.
